

**ICU BED** 

# **FULLCHAIR POSITION**

#### TO ACTIVATE:

- Make sure brakes are set.
- Press and hold the Chair control on the siderail or caregiver pendant. The bed transitions to the reclined position then to the Chair position.
- has reached the FullChair position.





If the footboard is not installed, the bed will proceed into Chair Egress.

# **CHAIR EGRESS**

#### TO ACTIVATE:

- Make sure brakes are set.
- Remove the footboard if installed.
- Press and hold the Chair control until the bed reaches the FullChair position and lowers completely.
- For beds with an air surface, seat deflate will activate to lower the patient. Bed will beep three times indicating the surface is deflated.
- Press and hold the Chair Control again to proceed to the Chair Egress position.
- If needed, press and hold the Chair control to inflate the back section of the surface to assist with the patient's egress.

If the footboard is installed, when the bed reaches the **FullChair** position, the articulation stops and a tone sounds. Remove footboard to continue to Chair Egress.

# SIDE EXIT ASSIST

# TO ACTIVATE:

- Raise or lower the bed so the patient's feet are flat on the floor.
- Press the Side Exit Assist control on the head end siderail. • After the seat sections inflates, assist the patient with bed exit.



• Press the Side Exit Assist control on the head end siderail.

# **BOOST POSITIONING SYSTEM**

# TO ACTIVATE:

- Press and hold the **Boost** control on the siderail.
- If the bed has an air surface, the surface will Max Inflate for 30 minutes and bed will transition to the Trendelenburg position.
- Release the Boost control when the desired position is reached.

To return to the flat position, press and hold the Bed Flat control. If the bed has an air surface, press the Normal control for the surface.

# NORMAL (CONTINUOUS LOW PRESSURE) MODE

Provides continuous full body pressure redistribution by automatically adjusting the surface to accommodate changes in weight distribution.

# TO ACTIVATE:

- Select the surface tab on the Colour Touchscreen.
- Select Normal





# **ALTERNATING PRESSURE MODE**

Pressure redistribution mode provides pressure relief through cyclical change in loading and unloading in the head, seat, and foot zones of the surface.

#### TO ACTIVATE:

- Select the surface tab on the Colour Touchscreen.
- Select Alternating Low Pressure (ALP).
- ALP is active when the control turns green.
- To change cycle time, press the dropdown time menu and select the desired time (10, 15 or 20 minutes).

### TO DEACTIVATE:

- Select the surface tab on the Colour Touchscreen.
- Press Normal.

# MAX INFLATE

#### TO ACTIVATE:

- Max Inflate times out after 30 mins
- Select the surface tab on the Colour Touchscreen. • Select P-Max Inflate.
- Alternatively, press the P-Max Inflate control on the

### TO DEACTIVATE:

- Select the surface tab on the Colour Touchscreen.
- Press Normal. Alternatively, press the P-Max Inflate control on





# **TURN ASSIST**

# TO ACTIVATE:

the siderail.

- Select the surface tab on the Colour Touchscreen. • Press Right or Left Turn Assist; the control turns
- green when active.
- To stop Turn Assist, press Normal.
- To pause the turn at less than the full angle, press the Stop Turn control while the Turn Assist is inflating.

# TO DEACTIVATE:

- Select the Surface tab on the Colour Touchscreen.
- Press Normal.

# **CONTINUOUS LATERAL ROTATION THERAPY**


# TO ACTIVATE:

- Select the Pulmonary Therapy tab on the Colour Touchscreen.
- Press Rotation.
- Select Full, Moderate, or Minimum. For custom options, select Custom (sets rotation direction, rotation percentage, and duration).
- If applicable, press Preview to check the patient's IV lines and tubes prior to starting rotation therapy.
- Press Start to begin Rotation.

# TO DEACTIVATE:

- Select the Pulmonary Therapy Tab on the Colour Touchscreen.
- Press Rotation.
- Press Stop Therapies.









# TIPS & TRICKS

# PERCUSSION AND VIBRATION (P&V)

- Select the Pulmonary Therapy tab on the Colour
- Select High, Medium, or Low. For custom settings, select Custom (sets intensity, frequency and duration
- · Press Start to begin P&V.

#### TO DEACTIVATE:

- Press the Pulmonary Therapy tab on the Colour Touchscreen.
- Select P&V.
- Press Stop Therapies.





# **BED EXIT ALERT**

# TO ACTIVATE:

- Ensure the patient is centered on the bed and aligned with the hip indicator.
- Select the Alerts tab on the Colour Touchscreen.
- Press Bed Exit.
- · Select Position, Exiting, or Out of Bed mode:
  - Position alerts when patient changes
  - Exiting alerts when patient moves away from the centre of bed toward edge of bed
  - Out of Bed alerts when patients weight has left the bed
- When the bed exit system is activated, and it detects and alert condition, an alert will sound and a message will appear on the colour touchscreen.

# TO DEACTIVATE:

- Press the Alerts tab on the Colour Touchscreen
- Press Bed Exit. Press Off.

### SILENCE BED EXIT SYSTEM WITHOUT **DEACTIVATING SYSTEM:**

- To Activate Preemptive Alert Silence Press the Silence control located at the
  - lower left of the colour touchscreen. This will allow patient movement or procedures to be done without the alert sounding.
- To Silence a Bed Exit Alert
  - When the bed exit system is activated and it detects an alert condition, an alert will sound and a message will appear on the color touchscreen.
  - Press Silence. Next, select Resume, Suspend, or Alert Off:
    - Resume immediately turns on the bed exit alert
    - Suspend allows 10, 20, or 30 minutes more time before the bed attempts to rearm the alert
    - Alert off turns the bed exit alert off

# SCALE

#### **ZERO THE SCALE:**

- · Make sure the patient is not in the bed.
- Select the Scale tab on the Colour Touchscreen • Press Zero and follow the on-screen instructions
  - New Patient
    - Erases Scale history
  - Zeros the scale
  - Reset all settings
  - Does not erase Scale History



• Ensure the patient is in the centre of the bed. • Select the Scale tab on the home screen.

Zeros the scale

- Press Weigh Patient then follow on-screen
- If the bed is not in the recommended position, the message "Not Required Position" message will show on the Colour Touchscreen; adjust the bed position as applicable.



- Select the Scale tab.
- Press History tab.

# PATIENT HISTORY

- Press the Settings menu tab on the Colour Touchscreen.
- Press History. • Select the desired history to be viewed:
  - Bed Exit Displays the time spent with the Bed Exit alert on
  - Head Angle Displays time spent with the head of bed more than 30 or 45 degrees since 12am with Head Angle alert active
  - Scale Displays the saved weights in the 24-hour period
  - Rotation Displays the maximum number of cycles/hour the patient has
  - rotated and hrs: mins in rotation in 24 hour period • P&V - Displays the number of Percussion and Vibration treatments provided per 24-hour period
  - Chair Displays time Spent in Chair position since 12am




